We kiss the wound of Your *Sacred Left Hand*, with sorrow deep and true in reparation for our sins and the sins of the whole world (now make the Sign of the Cross and Repeat for each wound...)

15 Repose of the Blessed Sacrament and Blessing

We pray: 'O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament Devine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine'.

In the absence of a priest or deacon:: 'May the Lord bless us and protect us from all evil and bring us to everlasting life.' Amen

A Reading from the Letter of St Paul to the Ephesians (3: 14-21)

For this reason, I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the Church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! 


12 A Prayer to Receive the Flame of Love

Now we will pray a prayer for receiving the Flame of Love. The prayer begins with a renewal of our Baptismal promises as recited during the Easter Liturgies:

Leader: Do you reject Satan? All: I do. Leader: And all his works? All: I do.

Leader: And all his empty promises? All: I do.



Leader: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father?

All: I do.

Leader: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

All: I do.

Leader: God, the all-powerful Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, has given us a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit and forgiven all our sins. May He also keep us faithful to Our Lord, Jesus Christ, for ever and ever. All: Amen.

Imagine yourself clothed in white garments, a symbol of your Baptism and of your future life in heaven with the angels and saints. Imagine an enormous fire. You enter into that fire. Do not be afraid. The fire is Jesus Himself; the Flame of Love. You are not alone; Mary is with you. You are in the deepest part of her heart, immersed in her Flame of Love. Mary fills you with great desires so that you want to receive more and more of this Flame, surrender to the Flame and to have Him consume your whole life.

This Flame, Jesus Himself, is the pearl of great price, the treasure hidden in the field, the whole purpose of your life. Allow the Flame to enter your being. Allow Jesus to fill your imagination and memory. Close your eyes and imagine Jesus living within you.

Imagine Jesus in the mysteries of the Rosary. He is conceived in Mary's womb. He sanctifies John the Baptist and Elizabeth. He is born into the world. The shepherds and the wise men can see God's human face. At forty days, He fills the temple with light. At twelve, He fills that same temple with His teachings.

4 Prayer Intentions

We pray in thanksgiving to God for the gift of life and creation, our shepherds, the dying, in honour of the Flame of Love of the Immaculate Heart of Mary for the release of holy souls from the place of suffering, our families, the unborn, the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the salvation of the whole world, our personal petitions...

The Most Holy Trinity and the Holy Virgin alone, the Angels and all the Saints, and with the assistance of all the souls delivered by you from Purgatory, are still able to provide for the needs of the Militant Church.'

3 The Descent of the Holy Spirit

Send forth Your Spirit, Lord, and give us the audacity of Your true disciples.

Jesus: 'I could compare this torrential flood to the first Pentecost. It will submerge the earth by the power of the Holy Spirit. All mankind will take heed at the time of this great miracle. Here comes the torrential flow of the Flame of Love of My Most Holy Mother. The world, darkened already by the lack of faith, will undergo formidable tremors and then people will believe!'

3 The Crowning with Thorns

May the thorns of our heart make the garden of our life blossom in faith with you, Mary.

Jesus: 'Without faith and trust, no virtue can take root in you. They are the foundation of this holy project for which we are preparing.'

4 Jesus Carries the Cross

May our daily cross be enlightened by the sorrowful Cross of Jesus, which has become glorious by His Resurrection.

Jesus: 'We give you the strength and courage to take the first steps, but you should not delay accomplishing My will, or simply dismiss it with the back of your hand.'

5 The Crucifixion

May the loving words uttered by Jesus on the Cross become seeds of life, love and forgiveness in all our hearts.

Jesus: 'If you do not come to Me, how then can I bestow My graces upon you? The fullness of graces is stored up in My Heart. My Heart is an unending source of love.'

Jesus: 'Should you want to speak publicly or if you were asked to do so, I will then be there to comfort you. Each word should be like a seed which must bear many fruits among your listeners.'

4 The Transfiguration

May our lives be transformed by the Holy Spirit, and may your Flame of Love, Mary, warm our hearts.

Jesus: 'The aim is to make known the value of the work of salvation! Ah! If only your aspirations for salvation could reach the throne of the Heavenly Father! The success would then be greater! Burn! Like the bush in flames of fire that did not burn up! I need a sacrifice that does not consume itself and whose fire reaches Me!'

4 The Assumption of Mary into Heaven

'I am the Resurrection and the Life.' May these words, Mary, maintain us in the hope and the certainty of an eternal tomorrow.

Mary: 'Only through speech can My Flame of Love become known. I am standing with sadness in my heart by the side of the world. You have no right to remain silent, neither by cowardice nor pride, neither by negligence nor fear of sacrifice. Mary: 'This Flame of graces springing from my Immaculate Heart has to go from heart to heart. This will be the great miracle whose light will blind Satan.'


The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple

3 Consecration of the Flame of Love Apostolate

Lady of Mount Carmel, Queen of heaven and earth, and Our Mother, through whom Almighty God has delighted to extend the greatest outpouring of graces to mankind since the Word became Flesh, we consecrate to your Immaculate Heart, completely and forever, the Flame of Love Apostolate, formed to assist you in saving your children, accelerating your Triumph and welcoming the Second Pentecost of the Holy Spirit, by spreading the effect of grace of your Flame. We ask you to guide us in this, your apostolate, so that our planning conforms to your wishes and our efforts are always performed in your name, the holy name of Mary. Enable us to grow, under your guidance, so that the effect of grace of the Flame of Love will spread over all humanity. Send additional priests, and the faithful, who will embrace your endeavours, and help our apostolate to expand throughout this entire country and beyond. Cover us with your scapular of protection and your mantle of unity, harmony and love; keep us steeped in humility so we do not falter. Strengthen us against all attacks of the enemy. Grant us the desire to share in the redemptive activity of your Divine Son. Keep us strong, active and resolute; grant that our inevitable frustrations and failures will make us more determined than ever to continue our efforts, increasing your glory and thereby, the glory of Jesus, Our Saviour. We ask nothing in return but the pleasure of serving you. Strengthen us in prayer and contemplation so that our apostolic actions may conform to your will and exceed expectations. Most Blessed Trinity, please approve our consecration and through Mary, Our Mother, enable our apostolate to return lost sheep to your merciful bosom for all eternity. Amen

At 30, Jesus is baptised. He receives the Holy Spirit and hears the Father's voice. He changes water into wine. He preaches, heals, drives out demons and proclaims that the Kingdom is at hand. He reveals His full glory to Peter, James and John. On the night before His death, He says, 'This is my Body' and 'This is my Blood'.

He goes to the Garden of Gethsemane where He accepts the Father's will. He gives Himself over to men whom Satan uses as his instruments. He accepts the wounds on His back and the thorns upon His head. He accepts the cross, walks to Calvary and dies for you.

His soul leaves His body and enters into eternal glory. Jesus' glorified soul reenters His body, glorifies it and raises it from the dead. He appears to His disciples, tells them to make disciples of all nations, and ascends to the Father's right hand. He sends the Holy Spirit upon the disciples, takes His Mother into heaven, body and soul, and then makes her Queen of all the angels and saints.

After imagining Jesus in these Gospel stories, allow the Flame to come to your will. You welcome Him and He enters your heart, you have invited Jesus to be the centre of your life. He is your King. Place this fire on the lampstand and Jesus' light will flood you.

When you receive the Flame with others, you experience the communion of saints. When one receives, all are blessed. When all receive, each is more blessed.

Right now, Our Lady embraces you and pours out Her Flame of Love in great abundance. This is a holy and sacred moment. She sends this Flame into your heart. The Flame leaps from her heart to yours. She gives the Flame without limits. The Flame of Love is so great that she suffers until the Flame leaves her heart and goes to yours, because it belongs in all our hearts. She gives the Fire far beyond your capacity to receive. She gives gifts that were meant for others, but they did not receive. Receive this Flame for everyone; for yourself, your family, your friends.

You will not realise all she has done for you this day. The effects will unfold slowly and powerfully. Be still. The prayer is complete. Our Lady is pouring out the effects of grace of the Flame of Love.

Remain in silence and receive.
